## Community Garden Participation Agreement 2018 Season

Gardeners are required to fulfill the following 5 obligations annually in order to maintain ownership of garden plot(s):

- 1. **EMAIL**: Maintain a valid email address. This will be the primary form of communication between staff and gardeners.
- 2. **CONTINUING EDUCATION**: Attend 1 gardening course of your choice through Duke Farms or another suitable vendor. Record title & date in the *Gardener Log Book*. **NOTE**: First year gardeners must complete 3 courses total: Orientation, Intro to Organic Gardening & a course of your choice.
- 3. **VOLUNTEER**: Complete 4 hours of volunteer time at Duke Farms for your first garden plot, plus 1 hour for each additional plot. Record hours in the *Gardener Log Book*.
- 4. **MAINTENANCE**: Keep your plot(s) weeded, harvested and well maintained. This includes arranging for plot care during periods of absence.
- 5. **GO ORGANIC!:** Use only OMRI (organic materials review institute) or organic approved materials in your plot(s).
