Additional Scrimmage Features:

- There will be a scale to weigh robots and unofficial mock inspections will be conducted
- If warranted for this year's game, we will have a sizing box available
- There will be volunteer judges interviewing teams throughout the day to help determine awards

Scrimmage Day Details

Arrival & Check-in

- Please Park in the student/visitor parking lot alongside Mullins Hall (#3 on attached map)
- Follow the sidewalk leading to the front doors of Mullins gym and check-in just inside the front doors.
- Turn in student waiver forms for all participants that have not previously submitted one to ICC during the 2015-16 academic year. (Starting February 1st we will prompt coaches to have team members attending the scrimmage register individually for our event records. Upon registration, they will be able to print the waiver form. Students that have attended an ICC training will register, but will not need a 2nd waiver form)

Unload: You may back your vehicle up to the side door (facing the parking lot) of Mullins to unload your robot into the gym.

Pit Area: An ICC student will be available to show you to your pit area (each team will have a 10X10 area). A table can also be requested.

Concessions:

- There will be regular concessions available throughout the day
- Tables will be set up in Wenger Hall and other areas for lunch; but students may also bring food back to the gym and eat lunch in the bleachers area if they choose.
- Plan for standard concession prices (money raised on concessions goes back into future course building and scrimmage expenses)

Please Bring:

- Game Pieces (important): Bring any of this year's game playing pieces your team has (marked with team name) to use during scrimmage matches. These items are typically expensive and available only in limited quantities; so we must rely on each of the teams to bring what you have.
- We will have access to our shop in Wenger Hall, but teams should bring their own tools for their pit area
- Teams should also bring safety glasses for everyone in their group if possible (we have some extra)
- Any items you want to try out in your pit area (we will have the 10X10 space, but will not have the tent & drape bars). However, if you have a banner, the pit areas will be against a wall that it could hang on.
