Hollee George AKA: Musko Giizhigo Ikwe (Red Sky Woman) is a Two Spirit Ojibway Woman from the Kettle and Stoney Point First Nation who has been working in the Criminal and Family Court Systems for approximately 19 years. While working for Indigenous people within these systems, she recognized a need for helping and healing in a capacity that the Province of Ontario had not truly embraced; particularly in Northern Ontario where her independent legal service originated. Born of her vision to help and heal not only the Indigenous people, but the systems, Wiidohkwin has been serving ALL Indigenous people across the Province of Ontario since 2008.
