

Workshop Program FAQs

LWB are committed to delivering a regular program of workshops on business related topics.

The workshops are a taster session and work to both impart knowledge to those attending and promote the business of the workshop leader. The principle being that everyone is left wanting more whilst also feeling inspired and able to do more than they could before attending the workshop.

Who delivers the workshops?

LWB members who work within areas or have skills that would be beneficial to many members are all welcome to deliver workshops within the Business Programme. Members are invited to propose their plan for an hour long workshop to LWB and to liaise with LWB in the timetabling of it.

Who administrates the workshops?

LWB cover all of the administration of the workshop: promotion; ticket allocation; venue hire; IT equipment and refreshments.

Any LWB delivering a workshop will be asked to provide copy for promotion of the event. This is the short paragraph of information that LWB then use to promote the event on the LWB website and through LWB social media.

How much does it cost to attend a workshop?

LWB are committed to keeping the workshop fee to members as low as possible and this will remain at £5 per ticket. Tickets will be offered first to LWB members. Any tickets remaining will be offered to non-members (Lewes based women in business only) at a cost of £15 each.

How much does the leader of a workshop get paid?

We pay between £35-55 for delivery of an hour-long workshop, depending on the number of attendees. We hope to fix this at the higher hourly rate, budget permitting.
