This one-day interactive workshop is designed primarily to assist clinicians working with youth who struggle with substance use disorders. The training will focus on treatment engagement and retention strategies, drawing heavily on principles from Motivational Interviewing, Collaborative Treatment Contracting, and the Adolescent Community Reinforcement Approach. The use of incentive-based interventions will also be explored.

Who Should Attend?

- **New Clinicians** to the substance abuse and/or mental health treatment field.
- **Established Clinicians** who have limited or no experience working with youth.

Note: *Those who have attended this training in the past may wish to re-attend as a booster session; some new content not previously included will be covered.*
