

### Directions to Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center

**From the North:** I-91 south to Exit 10S (Airport-New Hampshire). Merge onto I-89 south and follow to Exit 18. Turn left at the end of the ramp onto Route 120 and follow the blue and white hospital signs for about 1.5 miles to the entrance to DHMC.

**From the South:** I-91 north to Exit 10S (Airport-New Hampshire). Merge onto I-89 south and follow to Exit 18. Turn left at the end of the ramp onto Route 120 and follow the blue and white hospital signs for about 1.5 miles to the entrance to DHMC.

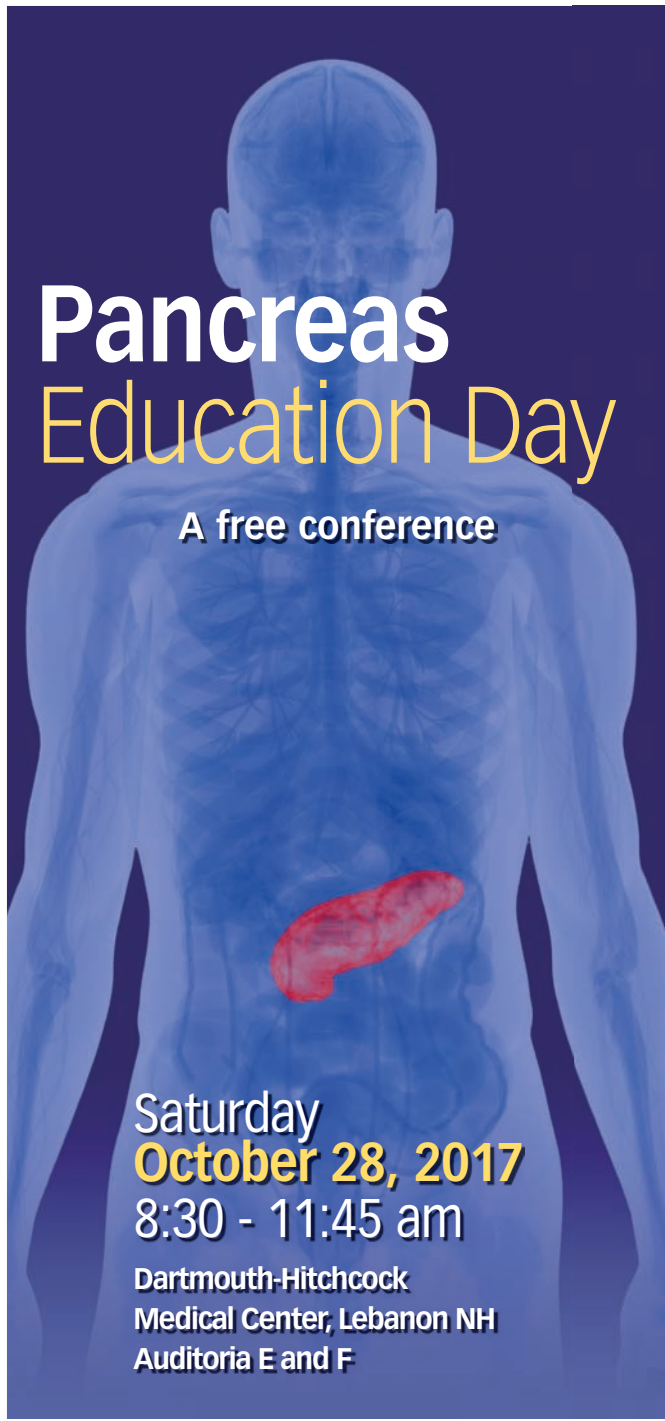
**From the West:** Route 4 to White River Junction, VT. Take I-89 south to Exit 18. Turn left at the end of the ramp onto Route 120 and follow the blue and white hospital signs for about 1.5 miles to the entrance to DHMC.

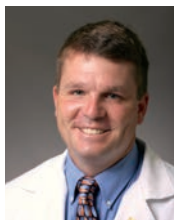
