Display	<p>The poster will be displayed for viewing at the event on 29 November in either the main conference space or in the market place.</p>
Judging	<p>The poster will be viewed and then judged by people with dementia and unpaid carers on 27 November, at a smaller local event that forms part of the engagement sessions being hosted by the Trust. The winner will be announced our main eventon 29 November.</p>
Poster Content	<p>The poster should tell the story of how your initiative demonstrates a Human Rights based approach to community and dementia.</p> <p>The poster should clearly explain what the initiative is about, how it benefits people with dementia and/or unpaid carers, and how it promotes human rights.</p> <p>Please make sure the poster is accessible to a broad range of people, e.g. make sure that the font size is</p>

sufficient, there is clear colour contrast and it is written in jargon-free English.
