GETTING HERE



Sir Tom Cowie Campus at St Peter's

The blue dots on the map show the available car parks on site. The red dot is the location of David Goldman Informatics Centre. There are two entrances into the building: one off St Peter's way leading to the first-floor entrance, and one from the right-hand car park, leading to the ground floor entrance.

St. Peter's campus at the University of Sunderland is very accessible by all means of transport.

Metro

The nearest metro stop is St Peter's and is a 10-minute walk away. The yellow dot on the map shows the location of this stop.

All University car parks are pay and display and cost £1.60 per hour.
