





## **SITE RULES**

## **4 BEARS CASINO & LODGE**

- 1. All boats are required to be inspected and washed on-site for aquatic exotic plants and animals.
- 2. Walleyes, minimum length 15 inches.
  - Each team will be allowed to weigh five walleyes per day.
  - 2.2. Only seven walleyes will be allowed in the holding well.
  - 2.3. The bump board at the tournament headquarters will determine the fish length.
  - 2.4. Weight scales will be open throughout the fishing day each day of the tournament. Any team may weigh their catch at any time. Once you weigh in for the day, you are done for the day.
- 3. Each team will be allowed seven fish in the boat and may weigh five.
- 4. Boundaries: Please see the attached map. Contact Ray Poitra (701-421-9880) at the 4 Bears Marina for any questions.
- 5. Dead Fish Penalty: Any dead fish brought to the weigh station will be subject to inspection and weighed in on the discretion of the weigh master.
- 6. Short Fish Penalty: Short fish will be culled from sack and no replacement will be accepted.
- 7. All flights will be eight hours any boat coming in late will be deducted one pound per minute. Boats arriving 15 minutes late will result in an automatic disqualification for the day.
- 8. Starting time: Safety is the only reason that the tournament will be delayed in starting on time. Starting time will be 7 AM CST.
- 9. Liability: 4 Bears Casino & Lodge, its managers, employees, promoters, tournament directors, sponsors and organizations assisting in the tournament operation and their agencies are not responsible for deaths, injuries, damages, liability, theft, fire or loss of any kind to entrants. Each entrant, upon signing an entry form, will be signing a waiver form.

- 10. Ties: All ties will be resolved by using the following methods:
  - 10.1. Largest number of live fish weighed
  - 10.2. Heaviest weight on day two
  - 10.3. Coin toss
- 11. Mandatory Check-in: All teams must check in and sign up with the tournament directors the evening of the rules meeting between 6 PM and 7 PM CST. There will be a free supper for all contestants starting at 6 PM in the 4 Bears meeting rooms. At least one team member must be present for the rules/safety meeting, which will begin at 7 PM CST.

## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

- Must be 18 years of age or accompanied by parent or quardian.
- 2. Must possess a valid state driver's license.
- 3. Each contestant will be allowed two lines in the water at all times (four per boat).
- 4. Cell phones and CB/marine radios may be used for emergency use only.
- 5. Only 200 teams will be allowed to sign up.
- Team numbers will be based on the time entry fee is received (which is acknowledged when payment is received in full).
- 7. Rules meeting will take place at 7 PM the Friday before the tournament.
- 8. Teams may substitute one member the day of the tournament.
- Request for entry fee refund must be in writing to the casino tournament coordinator one week prior to the tournament date.
- 10. Entry fee for all stops is \$200 plus a \$20 registration fee per two-person team.
- 11. Tribal fishing licenses are required of TAT tribal members 16 years of age and older fishing anywhere within the Fort Berthold Indian Reservation.
