



Welcome to Platte County Children's Trust Fund Golf Tournament!!

On behalf of the Platte County Children's Trust Board members, along with the entire golf staff and club we welcome you to Shiloh Springs Golf Club. The following is a brief description of your event's rules and format.

FORMAT:

Today's event is a Scramble Format. Each player on the team will hit a tee shot from their respective tees. The best tee shot will be selected as the team drive, and all other players will move their golf balls to this shot. From the best tee shot all players will play a second shot and the team will select the best shot as their second shot. This process is continued until the ball is holed out and the score made on the hole will be recorded as the team score. If your team only has three players, Please alternate the fourth shot amongst the group throughout all 18 holes. These shots must be taken in the same order decided from the start. Please record all your team scores on the scorecard provided with every person's name on the card. At the completion of play, please turn in your official card to the Golf Shop; scoring will be posted in the banquet room following play.

Special contests for today's competition are being held on the following holes:

- Hole #7: Closest to the Pin – TBD
- Hole #8: Closest to the Pin – TBD
- Hole #18: Closest to the Pin – TBD
- Hole #12: HOLE IN ONE - TBD
- Hole #14: HOLE IN ONE – TBD
- Hole #15: Long Drive – TBD
- Putting Green – Putting Contest – TBD

String Rules: Each Player that has purchased a "Contest Package" will receive a 2 foot string. Strings can be combined with other team member purchased strings. If a 4 person team all purchased string, then the total string available would be 8 feet. String pieces are used as an extension of a golf shot. Once a section of string is used, it must be cut from the total and not used again. You may use as many strings per hole as you have shots.

Mulligan Rules: Each Player that has purchased a "Contest Package" will receive 2 mulligans. A mulligan, most simply put, is a "do-over" in golf. Hit a bad shot? Take a mulligan and replay that stroke. Drop a ball on the spot from which you just played, and re-play. The first (bad) shot is not counted.

Putting Contest Rules: Each Player that has purchased a "Contest Package" will receive 2 putts in the putting contest. Players may purchase 2 additional putts for \$5 at the putting contest location. There is no limit on the amount of additional putts that may be purchased. The player that makes a putt, or comes closest, wins the contest. In the event of a tie, there will be a putt off.

Closest to the Pin Rules: ALL players will be eligible for the closest to the pin contests. The player that comes closest to the pin wins the contest. A mulligan **CAN** be used on a closest to the pin hole.

Long Drive Rules: Each Player that has purchased a "Contest Package" will be eligible for the long drive contest. There will be Men's and Women's contest. An eligible drive **MUST** be in the fairway of Hole # 15.

Hole in One Rules: ALL players will be eligible for the Hole in One contests. A hole in one is when a ball hit from a tee shot finishes in the cup. A Hole in One, on any hole, **IS** eligible to win the trip to Mexico, even if it is a mulligan. A Hole in One **IS NOT** eligible to win the Harley or car if it is a mulligan.

All play is from the WHITE TEES for Gentlemen under 65, GOLD TEES for Gentlemen over 65, and RED TEES for Ladies. Please utilize the 90 Degree rule when driving carts into the fairways on all holes.

All Ties will be broken by a scorecard playoff beginning on the lowest handicap hole and counting backwards, by hole handicap, one hole at a time on the scorecard.
