Beach Clean-Up Safety Information

- If there will be children participating, they should be supervised by adults at all times. Review the buddy system. This is where everyone will be assigned a buddy with whom they will work on the cleanup and for whom they will be responsible.
- If you see a needle or syringe, LEAVE IT ON THE SAND DO NOT PICK IT UP, notify the local ranger or city employee and mark the place with a stick stuck in the sand.
- DO NOT TOUCH STRANDED, INJURED OR DEAD ANIMALS.
 For dead animals, notify Park Ranger: 897-1941
 For injured birds, notify Wildlife Care Network: 966-9005
 For injured mammals, notify Marine Mammal Center: 687-3255
- **4.** Advise your group not to swim in areas without lifeguards.
- **5.** Prepare appropriately for the weather. Wear layers and include a wind-breaker. Consider bringing hats, sunblock, water, and snacks.
- 6. If there are large items you can't remove from the beach, please let the Creeks Division know what and where they are, and we will send our contractors out to retrieve them.
- 7. Please leave trash collected either in or next to existing trash can in park area.
