- We will meet outside the visitor center no later than 8:45 a.m. We strongly suggest you
 arrive at the Natural Area early to avoid wait time at the fee booth. If you arrive at the
 visitor center after 9:00 a.m. and the group is not there, please walk into the visitor center and
 inform a Ranger. He/she will contact the program leader and make arrangements to get you to
 the training site.
- You <u>do not</u> need to bring any gear with you to the visitor center as we will only go over a
 few things and then caravan as a group to the actual class facility. Please see the packing
 list on the next page for details about the gear you will need at the training site.
- We will go as a group to and from the training facility. There are plenty of parking spaces at the
 facility but we will have a short walk to the actual training site. Restrooms are available at the
 facility and are near the parking area.
- Be prepared for the weather by having proper clothing/outerwear with you.
- Please bring water, a lunch and/or snacks.
- A reminder: Knives must have a sheath and blade length should be no longer than 5-1/2". No machetes or "Rambo" knives.

Wilderness Survival Basics Packing List

The items listed below are the *minimal* items to bring. If you have other items you would like to bring that relate to camping or survival, it is acceptable.

| *Hunting/Survival Knife | 1 Mandatory | * Parental discretion advised. Minors must have expressed permission from parent or guardian in order to use knife. Knife will be used heavily during fire craft portion of class. Knives must have a sheath and blade length should be no longer than 5-1/2". No machetes or "Rambo" knives. |
| Ferrocerium Rod/Fire steel | 1 Mandatory | Can be purchased at REI or Academy. |
| Metal Container | 1 Mandatory | Will be used to boil water over fire. |
| Altoids Tins Thorsaldsord PROPERTY OF THE PR | 2(two) empty Mandatory | Will be used for creating char-cloth and a fire tinder container. |
| Backpack | 1 Mandatory | Have all your gear in 1 pack of your choice. |
| Food - Snacks | Optional | We will have a few breaks and time for lunch. |
| | Strongly Suggested | Dress for the weather and environment. Proper outdoor clothing and footwear highly suggested. |
