



STONEWALL STATE PARK FOUNDATION THE FIRST TEE OF WEST VIRGINIA GOLF TOURNAMENT RULES & PRIZES October 12, 2018

We hope that you enjoy your day on The Palmer Course! Lunch will follow play in Lightburn's restaurant along with awards presentations.

Participants can choose from one of the two following formats prior to start of play. Shamble format is a two-man best ball (gross and net) while the scramble format is scored as a gross (without handicap). Separate Prizes will be awarded for each format.

Option 1: <u>Shamble format</u>-each player will tee off from the teeing ground. The team will then choose the ball/location they wish to play from. Each player will then play their own ball until it is holed. The team will record the best individual gross and net score for the hole in space provided on the scorecard. The low net and gross score may come from the same golfer. Maximum score for an individual is net double bogey. If a player's score will not be used for the team net score, please pick up to speed play. Each player must use at least 3 tee shots on the front nine and 3 tee shots on the back nine.

Option 2: <u>Scramble format</u>-each player will tee off from the teeing ground. The team will then choose the ball/location they wish to paly from. All players will then hit a shot from that location and then again select the best shot. This format will be played until the ball is holed. MAXIMUM SCORE FOR TEAM IS DOUBLE BOGEY. Each player's tee shot must be selected once on the front 9 and once on the back nine as the team's first shot.

RULES:

- Men will play from the blue tee markers
- Senior men (60 & over) will play from the white tee markers
- Ladies will play from the red tee markers
- Handicap strokes for Shamble format participants will be marked on the scorecard provided for the SHAMBLE EVENT.
- Mulligans are available at \$20/team for the SHAMBLE format and \$40 for the SCRAMBLE format with one mulligan per player. MULLIGANS MAY NOT BE USED FOR HOLE IN ONE OR PROXIMITY PRIZES.
- In case of a tie we will have a regressive scorecard playoff beginning with hole #18 for both SHAMBLE AND SCRAMBLE COMPETITIONS.
- All tall grass (higher than 6") is played as a LATERAL HAZARD. Drop to be taken where the ball LAST CROSSES THE GRASS/HAZARD LINE --- NOT AT THE POINT WHERE THE BALL COMES TO REST.

Prizes and details for proximity contests for long drive, closest to the hole, longest putt, etc. will be announced prior to start of tournament.
