

How do I get there?

Sundown Cinema is located in the car park of Penrith Homemaker Centre. We are located on the Cnr Mulgoa Rd & Wolseley Street, Jamisontown 2749. We encourage all guests to park in the undercover car park - Drive through the Patty's Place entry and turn right at the round-a-bout. Drive straight towards Fantastic Furniture and head down the ramp to park undercover.

What time does the pre-movie entertainment & film start?

The pre-movie entertainment will commence from 5:30pm. The screening will commence at approx. 7:45pm depending on sunset. We suggest arriving early to ensure a great spot. Give yourself time to relax and enjoy a bite to eat before the film.

Can I BYO?

BYO alcohol is not permitted at Sundown Cinema Penrith Homemaker Centre. However, you are welcome to bring your own snacks. We will have a series of food trucks onsite for food purchases.

What should I wear/bring?

Sundown Cinema is an outdoor cinema, and it can get chilly once the sun goes down! Be prepared and pack a jumper just in case. The car park will be lined with AstroTurf - we recommend you bring a picnic rug, fold out chairs or pillows.

Where can I park?

Undercover parking is available at Penrith Homemaker Centre. Drive through the Patty's Place entry and turn right at the round-a-bout. Drive straight towards Fantastic Furniture and head down the ramp to park undercover.



What are the seating arrangements?

BYO bean bags, low beach chairs, cushions, blankets and rugs! If you need to bring a full height chair, please consider your fellow guests and be aware that we may ask you to move to the side or back of the seating area.

What food and drinks are available?

There will be a series of food trucks at the event, including Rolling Schnitzel & G-Dup Burgers, providing a delicious range of meals, snacks and hot and cold drinks.

How much do tickets cost?

Nothing! Zero! It's FREE! The only cost will be from your purchases from the various food trucks.

What if it rains?

As an outdoor event Sundown Cinema is subject to weather. We will try to go ahead with screenings wherever possible, and will not cancel for light/intermittent/potential rain. We strongly recommend you bring wet weather gear in case of rain.

The event will be cancelled only if the weather poses a safety threat to patrons and staff. We will aim to cancel as early as possible, however as weather conditions are unpredictable we may have to cancel close to or during the screening.
