Dr. Rosaly Lopes (Jet Propulsion Laboratory, NASA, USA)

Dr Lopes was born and raised in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. She studied Astronomy at UCL, London and developed an interest in planetary geology and volcanology. She is in the Guinness Book of World Records (2006) as the discoverer of the most active volcanoes anywhere, having discovered 71 on Jupiter's moon Io.



Sir Prof Stephen Sparks FRS (University of Bristol, UK)

Prof Sparks studied at Imperial College and is recognised as a world-leading volcanologist. He was appointed a Knight Batchelor in the 2018 New Year Honours list for services to volcanology and geology and has worked extensively with the media - most notably on the BBC Horizon documentary 'Supervolcanoes'.
