- 1. SEP examination typically requires paying an ~\$80 testing fee to a 3rd party testing center.
- 2. An examinee is not required to apply for SEP certification prior to taking the exam. Examinee has option to apply for certification after taking the exam and receiving the results. Standard application fees (CSEP: \$300-member / \$400-nonmember; ASEP: \$150-member /-nonmember) would apply.
- 3. Examinees must register for the conference to be eligible to sit for the exam. https://2014incoseregional.eventbrite.com. Register by Mon, 9/1, (conference early-bird deadline) to receive a hard copy of INCOSE Systems Engineering Handbook (version 4) to use as a reference for preparing for the exam. Limited number of seats ... Enrollment will continue until filled.
- 4. As with the conference, an attendee is not required to be an INCOSE member to participate in the exam.
