

Directions to The Meadows Office Building

The Otsego County Department of Planning and Solid Waste is located in The Meadows Office Building, located on County Route 33W, about 5 miles south of Cooperstown. The Meadows Office Building is the county's former nursing home. The building is located about one mile east of NYS Route 28 near the hamlet of Hyde Park.

Directions: *From Cooperstown:* Take NYS Route 28 south about 3 miles to Hyde Park. Near the Red Carpet Inn, look for the green and white directional sign to The Meadows and make a left onto County Highway 11C. Go to the end of 11C, look for more signs and make a right onto County Highway 33. Go about one-half mile and turn right onto County Highway 33W. The building is on the right. You should park in the main parking lot just beyond the building.

For daytime meetings, come into the building through the main front entrance and get directions to the Planning/Solid Waste Department from one of the security guards. Or, if it has been pre-arranged, you may come directly to our meeting room by entering the building as described in the following two sentences. *For nighttime meetings,* come into the building through one of two side doors on the back wing of the building and near the parking lot. The left door will immediately bring you into Classroom B; the right door will bring you into Classroom A.

Directions: *From Oneonta:* Take NYS Route 28 north through Hartwick Seminary, past McDonalds and the Holiday Inn Express, and into Hyde Park. Just past the Hartwick No. 2 Fire Hall, look for the green and white directional sign to The Meadows and make a right onto County Highway 11C. Go to the end of 11C, look for more signs and make a right onto County Highway 33. Go about one-half mile and turn right onto County Highway 33W. The building is on the right. You should park in the main parking lot just beyond the building.

For daytime meetings, come into the building through the main front entrance and get directions to the Planning/Solid Waste Department from one of the security guards.
