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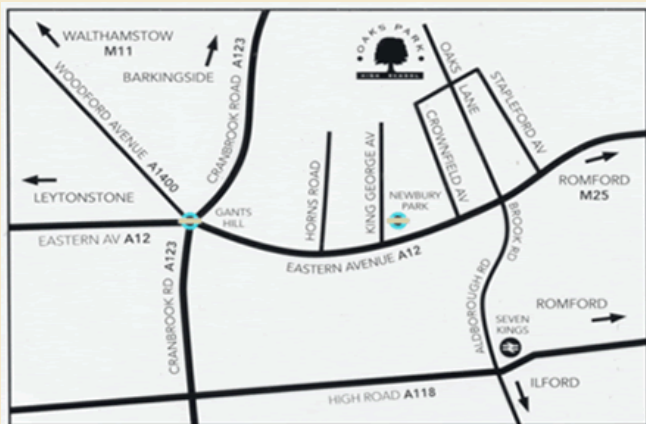
We are about 8 minutes walk from Newbury Park tube station on the Central Line.

We look forward to welcoming you.

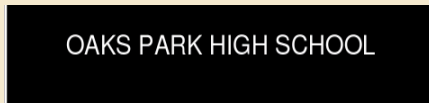

Date	Topic
Thursday 19 th January	Session 1: Introduction to Fronter We will be looking at what Fronter has to offer, how to get started with a room and some simple page creation.
Wednesday 1 st February	Session 2: Making Fronter interactive 1 This session looks at forums and hand-ins which encourage student participation.
Thursday 8 th March	Session 3: Using Fronter in practice 1 Opportunity to look at how different schools are using Fronter and what they find most effective.
Wednesday 21 st March	Session 4: Whole school implementation This session looks at different models for developing Fronter use across the whole school.
Thursday 10 th May	Session 5: Specialised rooms We will be looking at rooms which focus on cross-curricular areas, such as careers and inter-school projects.
Wednesday 23 rd May	Session 6: Making Fronter interactive 2 This session looks at votes and tests which encourage further student participation.
