## John Simpson

Please join us to celebrate the many contributions John Simpson has made to the rehabilitation and advocacy efforts in the brain injury community in British Columbia.

John Simpson was born and educated in Dublin, Ireland and became involved in rehabilitation in 1969 as an insurance adjuster. He was involved in the Rehabilitation Department of ICBC in 1979 and developed a keen interest in the area of brain injury.

In 1981, he began providing case management services through his own company, Simpson Rehab Management. John was a founding board member of the BC Head Injury Association in 1982 and has served on the boards of the Canadian Paraplegic Association, Cheshire Homes Society.

He founded the Fraser Valley (East) Brain Injury Association in 1997 and although he retired in 2001, continues to serve in a variety of volunteer and consultant roles within the organization.

John Simpson has been a pioneer in the movement to improve services for people with acquired brain injuries. For almost forty years, he has averaged more than 50 hours a month of volunteer time; advocating for families and survivors of brain injury, meeting with government officials, funders and service providers. He is a mentor for professionals and is recognized throughout Canada and the United States for his work in the brain injury field.
