GENERAL STANDARDS (CORE) - The category is a basic examination that includes general knowledge of proper pesticide use and pesticide safety. This exam is required for all licenses.
 Training manual: SM1— Applying Pesticides Correctly

AQUATIC PEST CONTROL -
 This category is applicable to individuals using or supervising the use of any restricted use pesticide to any standing or running water, including banks or shorelines.
 Training manual: SM3 - Aquatic Pest Control

NATURAL AREAS PEST CONTROL - This category is applicable to individuals who use or supervise the use of restricted use herbicides to control unwanted vegetation to protect natural communities of conservation and recreation lands and natural areas.
 Training manuals:
 SP 295: Natural Area Weed Management
 SP 242: Control of Non-native Plants in Natural Areas of Florida

RIGHT OF WAY PEST CONTROL - This category is applicable to individuals using or supervising the use of restricted pesticides, or other pesticides requiring licensure, in the maintenance or right-of- way areas associated with public roads, electric power lines, pipelines railroads, and other similar areas, but not including the use or supervision of restricted use fumigant pesticides.
