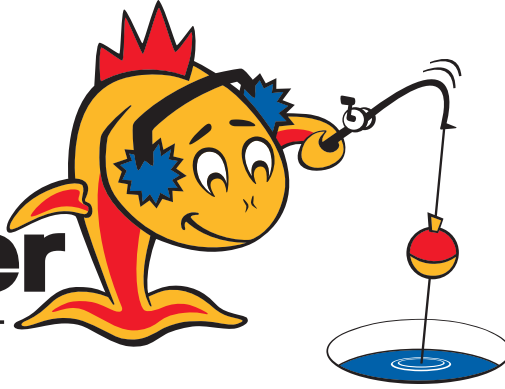

Whalen's Moving And Storage Cardboard Sled Race

Sleds are raced down the dike with

- 3 Decorate to make it look awesome
- 4 Race it down the hill and hope it stays together



Awards for the following categories:

Fastest sled
Slowest sled
Most creative
Most colorful

Two age classes:

Class I for ages 12 and under
Class II for ages Over 12 years old

Rules:

- Have fun!
- There is no charge for participation.
- Sled construction should only consist of cardboard, glue, and/or tape, paint and/or colored paper products.
- Your sled must be free of sharp edges and other features that may be deemed dangerous. If you are unable to remove objects from your sled you will not be allowed to compete.
- Hard items that could be dangerous to you or other event participants cannot be used (ie. wood, glass, metal)
- Use Tape and/or Glue to hold your sled together. You may not use screws, nails, or staples or other materials deemed dangerous.
- Your sled cannot be wrapped in plastic, tape, or shrink wrap.
- The pilot and all riders must have read and understood the rules.
- You must pass inspection prior to competing.
- Helmets are encouraged but not required.
- To qualify as a finisher you must be in your sled.
- This is a family friendly activity; no alcohol is permitted in the sled area.
- A parent/guardian 18 years old or over must accompany entrants under 18 years old and complete the registration form (doesn't have to ride in the sled).
